3. Background and Experience

TropicalAstral Lda is a private adult education provider and translation company, focused mainly on corporate clients in the Algarve area providing private executive business language lessons. In addition to language training, TropicalAstral offers translations, proofreading, editing, voice-overs, subtitling, graphic design and social media marketing services.

TropicalAstral also offers a wide range of services aimed at enhancing business growth and/or market (re)positioning. They are a secret shopper provider and they have local businesses as their clients, providing social media management for restaurants, bars, real estate, app creators, tour operators, and aesthetic service providers.

TropicalAstral can provide website and mobile application design and build, and social media creation and management. Providing clients with integrated social media strategies based on competitor benchmarking and market positioning. TropicalAstral has significant in-house experience in educational resources, website creation and mobile application development, and content building.

The owner and key employee of TropicalAstral have also created the teachers' tool website "The Language Menu", which has a member base of around 35,000 teachers worldwide. This technical and creative expertise is also a key contribution that TropicalAstral can bring to a project.



While TropicalAstral is a fairly newly incorporated company that started in January 2020, it has staff working from many different countries, most of which have previously been involved in EU projects in the past. Tropical Astral also offers teacher training courses, courses on entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and social media marketing. Teaching material made by TropicalAstral staff can be found (free of charge) in different languages on Scribd.com, TeachersPayTeachers, SlideShare, and many other platforms on the internet.

They run the group <u>Vilamoura and Algarve Internationals</u> which has over 5600 members. This group is also the key to local dissemination for projects.

TropicalAstral also organises weekly mingles and other monthly events in the area. They have at the moment 10 staff, both full-time and part-time, some volunteers and about 30 learners at our free Portuguese lessons which we deliver for both beginners and intermediate levels once a week in Vilamoura.

Areas of activity: research, content creation, language courses, translations, social media marketing, website development, web portal development, benchmarking tools, teacher tools, phone app development, language cafe...

Youth

TA aspires to involve youth in its operations, both to help youth gain useful experience but also to capitalize on the younger generation's aptitude with social media to strengthen TA's capabilities in that area. While varying over time, between 20-30% of TA's employees have been youth under the age of 25.

Integration of foreigners in the Algarve

TA was founded by a newcomer to Portugal with the clear ambition to utilize the non-domestic talent available that for various, primarily language barrier, reasons had difficulties securing employment in Portuguese managed companies. Additionally, TA identified a clear need for immigrants coming to Portugal without Portuguese language knowledge, to get support with navigating the process of becoming a bona fide resident in Portugal. This lead to a number of TA activities and courses to serve



as a point of contact with other newcomers as well as a center for exchange of knowledge and experiences.

School

TA staff have over the years sought cooperations with various educational facilities and as result partnered with both VET educators as well as several Universities, both in Portugal and internationally.

Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship has been at the cornerstone of TA since the beginning. Not only is the founder herself a serial entrepreneur but also a person that sees and seizes opportunities as they arise. Helping others establish business is an area that TA staff have experience of and been involved in various projects on related topics. TA has also encouraged staff, having joined as junior associates, to venture on to establish their own business as professional development and continue to collaborate in such capacity.

Local engagement

TA continuously seek opportunities to interact with the local communities where TA has activity. This commonly manifests itself in choices of venues for more public activities, e.g. weekly meetups where TA seeks to vary the venues to and establish ties to local business and generate revenue for these. TA is the owner and moderator of the <u>Vilamoura & Algarve Internationals</u> group that has over 5600 members.

Inclusion & Diversity

Related to TA's involvement with education, integration and local engagement TA's staff have also been involved in efforts and projects aimed at increasing inclusion and diversity, including financial literacy and gender equality.

IT & Graphic Design

Our staff has worked for many years with IT, created websites, web portals, web tools, benchmarking tools, tools for teachers, phone apps in both Android and iOS as well as VR and AR games. We have a dedicated social media team as well that is available for dissemination, graphic design, designs for brochures, flyers, e-books etc



TropicalAstral staff have extensive experience leading dissemination/valorisation and working with social media for EU project dissemination. Their staff have been involved in over 50 EU projects, including Erasmus+, TOI, Justice, Grundtvig and Mobility projects since 2008, both as partner and coordinator. They have worked on several projects involving integration and language learning for immigrants.
